



Born July 7, 1958 is an American short story writer and novelist.

McCorkle was born in Lumberton, North Carolina. She graduated from University of North Carolina, in 1980, where she studied with Max Steele, Lee Smith, and Louis D. Rubin. She also attended Hollins College now Hollins University with Lee Smith where she received her MA. She taught at Tufts University, University of North Carolina, Duke University, Harvard University and Bennington College. She teaches at North Carolina State University.

Hieroglyphics

A mesmerizing novel about the burden of secrets carried across generations. Lil and Frank married young, launched into courtship when they bonded over how they both suddenly, tragically lost a parent when they were children. Over time, their marriage grew and strengthened, with each still wishing for so much more understanding of the parents they'd lost prematurely.

Now, after many years in Boston, they have retired in North Carolina. There, Lil, determined to leave a history for their children, sifts through letters and notes and diary entries perhaps revealing more secrets than Frank wants their children to know. Meanwhile, Frank has become obsessed with what might have been left behind at the house he lived in as a boy on the outskirts of town, where a young single mother, Shelley, is just trying to raise her son with some sense of normalcy. Frank's repeated visits to Shelley's house begin to trigger memories of her own family, memories that she'd rather forget. Because, after all, not all parents are ones you wish to remember.

Hieroglyphics reveals the difficulty of ever really knowing the intentions and dreams and secrets of the people who raised you. In her deeply layered and masterful novel, Jill McCorkle deconstructs and reconstructs what it means to be a father or a mother, and what it means to be a child piecing together the world all around us, a child learning to make sense of the hieroglyphics of history and memory.



Delta Bingo Volunteers

This is an important and ongoing fundraiser for Mapleridge Recreation Centre. Volunteers work in teams at the Delta Bingo Hall where they greet and interact with attendees, and help ensure a smooth delivery of the bingo experience. No money-handling is required. Volunteers commit to a 2 1/4 hour shift, once or twice per month. Training is provided.

Front Door Reception Volunteers

Volunteers create a positive first impression of Mapleridge Recreation Centre. They greet members and visitors, use a touch-screen to complete member sign-in, and punch the User Fee Card. The duration of a shift is 3 or 4 hours. Each volunteer decides how many shifts they do. Training is provided.
